

This whimsical tulle overlay is the perfect bridal accessory. It's function plays double duty... First, it's an unexpected way to tie your dress and veil together with minimal effort and expense. Secondly, it's a great way to dress up any gown in a cinch, making it easy to change your entire bridal look from vows to the reception.

To make the tulle overlay for wedding dress, simply disassemble two, curly-edged tulle veils from their headpieces. Cut a length of ribbon (be sure to allow enough to wrap around waist and for a loopy bow and lengthy streamers). Lightly iron tulle and stitch top of veils to length of ribbon.



Lengths of sheer ribbon float around this romantic piece.

Using a two-tiered veil with a curly-edge, we simply trailed lengths of delicate floral-embellished ribbon from the top of the veil. We secured ends of ribbon to comb base using a few quick stitches.

A short and sassy veil is a perfect choice for the ultra-modern bride.

Gathered layers add height and drama to this wispy piece, while a delicate pearl spray sewn to the headcomb adds a hint of romance.
